- In early 1990 the Columbia 145.11 repeater linked with Williamston 145.41 which started the linking system. Over the next couple of years several other repeaters linked in. Around 1993 Columbia **[UHF** 443.3001 and Williamston [UHF 444.250] put up a system which then became the backbone we have today.

There was good participation from the group and the educational portion of the meeting ended at 9:10 pm.
